Approval of the Agenda – Moved by Gunderson, seconded by Cumberledge; Ayes: Unanimous.

New Business:

Public Hearing to receive comments concerning the 2017-18 Budget, required notice was published in the Daily Nonpareil on Friday March 17. No verbal or written comments have been received. Tim Rohwer of the Daily Nonpareil was present and asked some questions of the clerk and council.

Gunderson moved to close the public hearing and Corcoran seconded the motion. Ayes: Unanimous.

Corcoran moved to approve the 2017-18 Budget as published, seconded by Gunderson. Ayes: Unanimous.

Communications from Councilman Gunderson, would like to discuss why the positions in the Police Department and Maintenance Department were not filled after previous employees resigned. Gunderson has visited with Chief Kannady who stated he will work with what he has for officers, but he was not in agreement with not filling the vacancy. Gunderson provided a list of projects from Supervisor Rothmeyer, that need to be completed by the Maintenance Department, and reiterated that being short one man is affecting the ability to get the list completed. The present Council members discussed adding part-time help in the summer. No action was taken.
