It is time to build on the recent successes and address the issues that will further build Carter Lake and fill that gap between the airport and the downtown entertainment district. We are currently meeting with a developer that wants to continue with the dining and entertainment attraction on Abbott Drive. If a snow emergency is declared by the mayor, the dates and times of the emergency will be broadcast on local radio and television stations. If there is more than 4” of snow and the mayor declares a snow emergency, there shall be no parking on the streets, avenues or alleys until they are cleared.
