## Letter From Mayor Cumberledge

Hello again,

The City's growth looks very promising for 2019 and I am looking forward to possibly more new commercial development. In order to promote and advance economic development, the City Council and I hired Lamp, Rynearson & Associates to give the City, its residents and businesses a comprehensive report of the City's sanitary and storm sewer system. These studies will be completed by May 1, 2019. The new information will give the City an opportunity to fully understand the impact on these systems and any new proposed development.

Here are a few of the services provided by the City in 2018:

Fire & EMS Department logged 483 calls.

Police Department made 5,182 contacts.

Senior Center served 5,756 meals.

Ballfields played over 500 games.

Library door count was 12,287.

Building Inspector issued 217 permits.

We are currently planning the new budget, with 5 workshops scheduled. It's a very long and challenging process. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me or any of the Council members.

## PET REGISTRATIONS

2019 Pet license's are available starting January 1st. \$10 for altered pet and \$15 for unaltered pet. Remember, after March 1st a late fee of \$5 per pet will be assessed to each license. Must bring copy of current rabies vaccination to purchase license.

## SNOW REMOVAL

Yes, it will snow AGAIN this year! Please remember that all sidewalks must be cleared of snow and ice within 24-hours after the snow stops. If you do not remove your snow and ice, the City may remove it and charge you the cost plus an administrative fee. Please keep your sidewalks clear of snow and ice.

## PROPER DISPOSAL OF LARGE ITEMS

Do you have a couch, chairs, or appliances that need to go to the landfill? It is the owner's responsibility to contact Red River Waste Solutions and pay a fee for pickup. 


The spirit of giving was in full swing at the 3rd Annual "Shop with a Cop" event on Wednesday, December 12, 2018.


