

CARTER LAKE CITY COUNCIL MEETING  
MONDAY, JULY 18, 2022

Mayor Ronald Cumberledge called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Roll call of the council, present: Ashley Wilson, Jackie Wahl, Pat Paterson, Keebie Kessler, and Victor Skinner; city clerk Jackie Carl and city attorney Mike O'Bradovich are present. Upon motion duly made by Paterson, and seconded by Skinner, the council's agenda was approved unanimously. Skinner moved to approve increase salary by 10% for Senior Center Director Linda Tice, seconded by Wahl; NO: Paterson, Wilson, Kessler YES: Skinner & Wahl. Kessler moved to set wage for Chelsea Bollom, library staff at \$18.00, seconded by Paterson; unanimously approved.
